



Call for abstracts to present at the joint Aberystwyth University and HEIW Simulation conference on 5th July 2023

The Simulation conference programme has a session dedicated to showcasing simulation-based innovations and best practice from across health and care education and training in Wales.

Abstracts are welcome on the following themes showcasing current practice, original research, case presentation, quality improvement or service evaluation activities or projects:

- **Interprofessional** simulation-based education and training
- **Mental Health** simulation-based education and training
- **Remote** simulation-based education and training
- **Pre-hospital** simulation-based education and training
- **Community** simulation-based education and training

Should you wish to submit, please write a **300-word abstract** (excluding title and references). Abstracts exceeding the work limit will not be considered.

The submitting author must confirm that all co-authors have agreed for the abstract to be submitted and that it is original work. The abstract should include the following:

Title

-Title of abstract

Introduction/background:

-Briefly explain the aim and objectives of the activity/development

Method/Activity:

-Consider-Why? Who? How? When?

Results/Findings:

-What was the outcome?

Conclusion/Discussion:

-What you learned from the experience?

-Next steps?

Deadline for abstract submissions: 21st May 2023

Abstracts will be reviewed and selected based on content, relevance and originality. All abstracts will be double blind, peer reviewed by the organising committee. *Successful individuals* will be contacted and asked to provide a face-to-face presentation at the conference. There will be a live Q & A session after all presentations to respond to any questions.
