

Call for abstracts to present your work at the Annual HEIW Simulation Conference on 29th June 2022

The Annual HEIW Simulation Conference will once again be showcasing recent innovations and examples of best practice in simulation from across health and care education and training in Wales. The programme for the day will be covering two key themes:

- Interprofessional simulation-based education and training
- Immersive Technologies and Extended Realities (including VR,MR, AR, 360 etc)

Should you wish to submit an abstract to showcase your work in either or both these fields of work, please write a **300-word abstract** (excluding title and references). Abstracts exceeding the word limit will not be considered.

The submitting author must confirm that all co-authors have agreed for the abstract to be submitted and that it is original work.

The abstract should include the following:

Title

-Title of abstract

Introduction/background:

-Briefly explain the aim and objectives of the activity/development

Method/Activity:

-Consider-Why? Who? How? When?

Results/Findings:

-What was the outcome?

Conclusion/Discussion:

-What you learned from the experience?

-Next steps?

Deadline for abstract submissions: 15th May 2022 by 16.00

Abstracts will be reviewed and selected based on content, relevance and originality. All abstracts will be double blind, peer reviewed by the organising committee. *Successful individuals* will be contacted and asked to provide a **7 minute live or video recorded presentation**. There will be a live Q & A session after all presentations and therefore we would ask for all presenters to be available on the day to respond to any questions.
