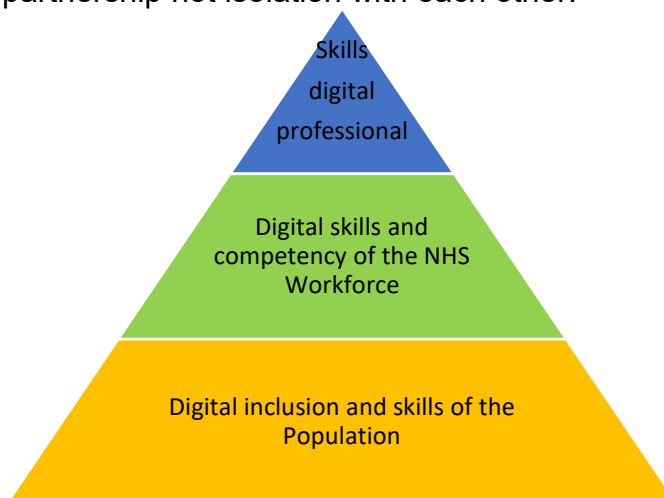

Objective
