Workplace Empowerment Programmes 2020

LGBT Role Models

Empowering LGBT individuals to step up as visible role models with the confidence and skills to be themselves, bring positive change to workplaces and communities and inspire others to do the same.

Allies

Empowering people who do not identify as trans to be active LGBT allies with the confidence, knowledge and skills to create inclusive cultures and impact positively on the lives of LGBT people.

Trans Allies

Empowering non-trans people with the confidence, knowledge and skills to better understand trans identities and lived experiences, and to bring about positive change in workplaces and communities for trans people.

Inclusive Service Delivery

Empowering staff in service delivery and public facing roles to have the knowledge and confidence to implement good practice and provide inclusive services to LGBT people.



LGBT Role Models

This programme offers LGBT people the opportunity to explore what it means to be a role model and the positive impact they can have in creating more inclusive environments. It is a CPD-accredited, one-day programme, which offers up to 36 people the chance to:

Understand what it means to be yourself.

Understand what it means to be an LGBT role model and ways to 'step up'.

Develop active listening skills and techniques for having productive conversations.

Identify an achievable action plan to step up as a positive and inclusive role model.

Increase motivation and confidence to be a visible and influential role model.

Become part of Stonewall's Alumni Programme to access ongoing opportunities to develop as an LGBT role model.

Allies

Stonewall's Allies programme empowers non-LGBT people to #ComeOutForLGBT. It enables them to explore what it means to be an ally and identify how they are going to create more inclusive workplaces and communities, and impact positively on the lives of LGBT people. This one-day, CPD-accredited programme offers the chance for up to 36 participants to:

Develop an understanding of how different identities shape our lived experiences.

Understand the diversity of LGBT experiences.

Develop active listening skills and techniques for having productive conversations.

Understand what it means to be an inclusive ally.

Develop an action plan to step up as an inclusive ally.

Become part of Stonewall's Alumni Programme to access ongoing opportunities to develop as an ally.

Trans Allies

Stonewall's new programme empowers non-trans people to be active trans allies with the confidence, knowledge and skills to bring about positive change in workplaces and communities for all trans people. This CPD-accredited, one-day programme, offers up to 36 people a powerful opportunity to:

Explore and understand trans identities, language and terminology.

Hear personal stories from trans people and learn about the lived experiences of trans individuals in society and at work.

Gain a deeper understanding of the impacts of transphobia on trans people and the wider communities.

Recognise their influence and responsibility in creating inclusive workplaces and communities.

Establish practical ways to step up as an effective and positive trans ally.

Become part of Stonewall's Alumni Programme to access ongoing opportunities to develop as an ally to trans people.

Inclusive Service Delivery

This programme has been developed to meet the specific needs of organisations and individuals that provide services to the public to ensure that LGBT inclusive services are provided across Wales, in line with Public Sector Equality Duties. It is a one-day programme, which offers up to 36 people the chance to:

Develop a greater understanding of LGBT rights and the issues faced by LGBT service users

Have a greater understanding of the expectations required under the Equality Act and Public Sector Equality Duty

Understand the need to effect positive change in terms of the services they deliver

Feel empowered to effect change and take away specific actions to positively impact on how they support LGBT service users and colleagues

Delivery Models

In House

Stonewall deliver to between 12 and 36 of the client's employees at the client's offices. There is scope for your employees to co-facilitate the programme with an expert Stonewall facilitator if they are part of the Stonewall Alumni Programme.

Open

Stonewall host a programme to which clients may send as many delegates as they like. Certain programmes are publicly open for application and there may be a selection process to secure a place.

Cluster

Two or more clients share the cost and delegate allocation of a programme. This collaborative approach brings employees or partners together to achieve the aims of the programme and build networks across participating organisations.
