 Each specialty training programme undergoing ST1, ST3, and/or run-through application process for post commencing in August 2021 and/or February 2022, with recruitment via yourselves rather than central HEE

## Output (for each individual specialty training programme as above)

- 1. The rank of the lowest ranked candidate offered a place, with those offered a place after the Upgrade Deadline separated out into a separate column. For example: "Urology run-through Position starting Aug 2021 - the lowest ranked candidate offered a place was ranked 100th. After the Upgrade Deadline, a candidate ranked 150th was offered a place."

## **Explanatory notes:**

- Candidates were not offered a place after the upgrade deadline and so we are unable to provide this information.
- Otolaryngology (ST3), Trauma and Orthopaedics (ST3), and the Wales Clinical Academic Track are the only specialty training programmes that Wales recruits locally. All other specialties and grades are delivered through national recruitment.
- The data relates to the August 2021 intake.
- The recruitment for the February 2022 intake was undertaken nationally. As HEIW did not hold local recruitment for the February 2022 intake we are unable to provide this information.
