HEIW and LHB review practice to determine if it meets				
their standards - visit to practice may be required				
LHB approve practice and notify HEIW				
Applicant makes PLVE application to HEIW which				
requires review via the PLVE process.				
Applicant to submit application electronically and				
enclose:

In Practice Mentor Application Form

2 x Clinical References				
Portfolio of evidence which includes CPD Certificates				
Applicant to submit their Portfolio along with				
supporting application paperwork to HEIW for review				
by a PLVE Panel to determine any outstanding				
competences as per the DFT curriculum. If the				
applicant chooses not to submit a portfolio, PLVE will				

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be unable to advise regarding the DFT curriculum or				
the length of supervised training required				
If the applicant is submitting an initial portfolio for				
review by PLVE Panel, a cheque for the full amount,				
the portfolio, and full application paperwork must be				
submitted prior to the published application closing				
date.				
If the applicant is submitting a portfolio, PLVE convene				
Initial Panel made up of 3 members to determine any				
outstanding competences as per the DFT curriculum. If				
required, a document is produced containing any				
outstanding competences and a period of supervised				
training may be required. All clinical competences must				
be assessed by Practice				
Supervisor; PLVE only review professional and				
managerial domains				
PLVE notify LHB if there are outstanding competences				
and supervised training is required. If the applicant did				
not submit a portfolio, it is assumed that supervised				
training is required, but PLVE will be unable to advise				
regarding the DFT curriculum or the length of				
supervised training required.				
Performer list complete required checks and notify the				
applicant of their proposed Performers List status				
(usually 'Dental Performer' or 'Dentist undertaking				
foundation training by assessment/ conditional				
inclusion').				
Period of supervised training begins - normally				
between 6 and 12 months with a maximum of 12				

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months (full time). Applicant must gather evidence of				
their attainment of competences with the support of				
the DPSU.				
Practice Supervisor must review and sign-off all clinical				
competences. They must assist applicant in the sign-				
off of all professional and managerial domains to be				
submitted to PLVE Panel.				
When the applicant is confident all of the missing				
competences have been evidenced, applicant submits				
portfolio to PLVE electronically. This must be				
submitted prior to the published application closing				
date and must be accompanied by payment.				
PLVE review portfolio to determine any missing				
evidence and notify applicant with a request to submit				
the missing information prior to the Panel date, if				
applicable.				
PLVE Panel convened to review if the gathered				
evidence meets the requirement for equivalence to the				
DFT curriculum with reference to professional and				
managerial domains and Satisfactory completion.				
PLVE notifies the applicant and the LHB of the decision,				
including a list of any remaining outstanding				
competences if appropriate.				
If equivalence confirmed, HEIW issue a				
certificate/number to the applicant				
If equivalence is confirmed, the LHB make appropriate				
amendment to applicant's National Performers List				
status. This ends the PLVE process for the applicant.				

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If equivalence is not demonstrated and the				
applicant has undertaken less than12 months of				
supervised training, the applicant can undertake				
further supervised training (up to 12 months) to gather				
evidence of the remaining competences.				
Once the applicant is confident all of the missing				
competences have been evidenced (or the maximum				
period of supervised training has been reached),				
applicant re-submits portfolio to PLVE electronically.				
This must be submitted at least 6 weeks before the				
published PLVE Panel dates and must be accompanied				
by payment.				
PLVE review re-submitted portfolio to determine any				
missing evidence and notify applicant with a request to				
submit the missing information prior to the				
Panel date, if applicable.				
PLVE Panel convene to review if the re-submitted				
evidence now meets the requirement for equivalence				
to the DFT curriculum with reference to professional				
and managerial domains and Satisfactory completion.				
PLVE notifies the applicant and the LHB of the decision,				
including a list of any remaining outstanding				
competences if appropriate.				
If at a subsequent PLVE Review Panel the applicant is				
confirmed as evidencing equivalence to the DFT				
curriculum, PLVE issue a certificate to the applicant of				
Satisfactory Completion.				

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If equivalence is confirmed at a subsequent Panel, the				
LHB will make the appropriate amendment to the				
applicant's National Performers List status. This then				
ends the PLVE process for this applicant.				
If following 12 months of supervised training (even if				
this is the applicant's first submission to the PLVE				
Review Panel), the applicant does not meet the				
requirements for PLVE, PLVE will notify the applicant				
regarding the missing competences and notify the LHB.				
If following 12 months of supervised training,				
equivalence is not confirmed, the LHB will determine				
whether the dentist should be included on Performers				
List and their status. This then ends the PLVE process				
for this applicant.
