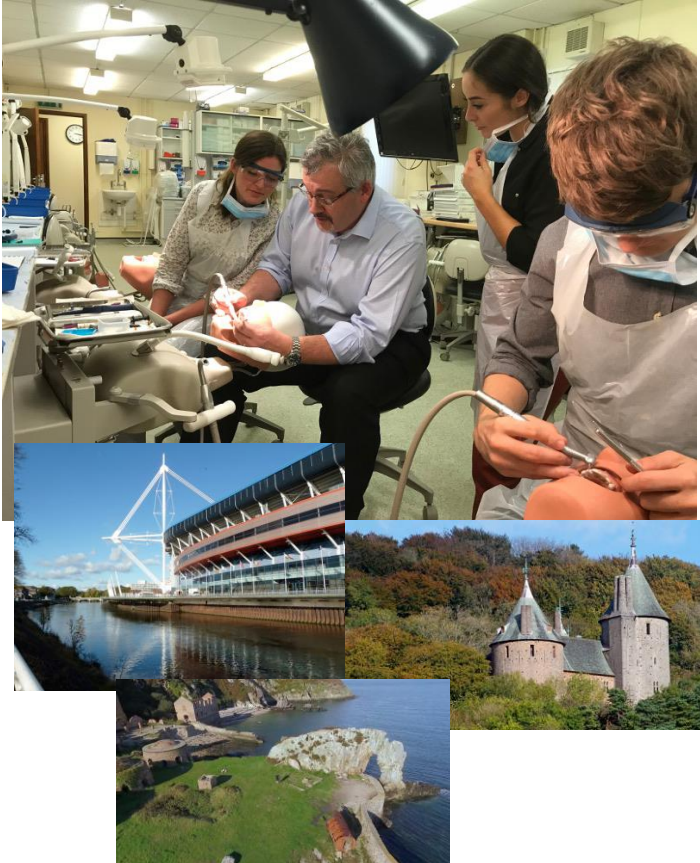

- The scheme covers the whole of Wales
- Automatic approval for existing DFT Educational Supervisors

- Preventive care
- Fillings (adults and children)
- Deciduous extractions
- Radiographs
- Impressions
- Local anaesthesia
- Hygiene treatment
- Periodontal treatment
- Hall Crowns
