Current picture in Wales



- Barriers to getting online (access, confidence and skills)
- 7% of the population of Wales not online
- 23% lack essential digital skills, this increases to 64% for people over 75.
- Older people, people with disabilities and limiting long term illness are less likely to be online

NHS interacts with a disproportionately high % of digitally excluded people

- Equip people with the motivation, access, skills and confidence to engage with an increasingly digital world, based on their needs.

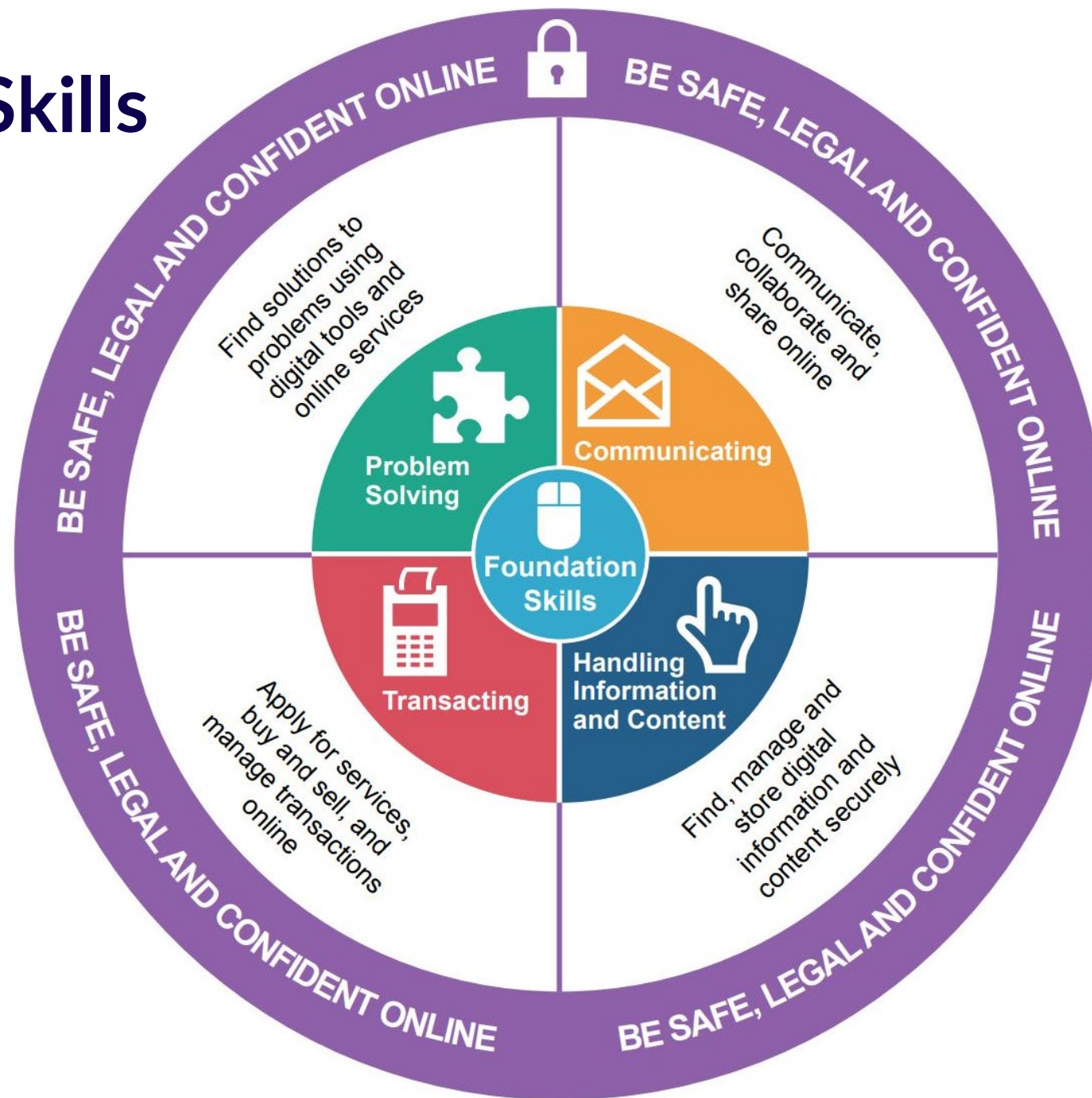
